Inter Tribal Health Authority (ITHA), a multi-disciplinary health organization providing services to 29 member First Nations on Vancouver Island based in Nanaimo, British Columbia is seeking a Community Health Nurse (CHN) to provide support to the ITHA's First Nations member community Tseycum First Nation, located in in North Saanich,

Reporting to the Nursing Manager, this position is responsible for –managing mandated CDC programs maternal child health and home and community care programs; family and individual client recommendations and participating in decisions relating to such things as education and new program design, public health - coordination and delivery, - family and individual client assessment, screening, evaluation and reporting (e.g. immunizations, home nursing care, pre-and post-natal women, infants, children, individuals with chronic/long-term illnesses, diabetes management and the elderly). This position also provides general professional health advice and information to individuals, families, and communities requiring health support and access to services and advocates for and bridges gaps between communities and external service agencies. Additionally, this position requires a good working relationship and collaboration with the First Nation Health Authority (FNHA) and Island Health's public health nursing, home and community care nursing and the Aboriginal Health team.

The ideal candidate has a Bachelor of Science, nursing degree, current CPR/AED Level C Certification, current immunization certification, and minimum two years' experience working as a Community Health Nurse in a rural/remote setting. Training of specific certifications will be provided for the right candidate. Other requirements include cultural competency in First Nation health and in professional nursing practice; knowledge or acceptance of traditional, homeopathic and other healing practices. Valid class 5 driver's licence and willingness to travel when necessary is required.
