Carrier Sekani Family Services (CSFS) is looking for an Aboriginal Patient Liaison to provide a bridge between aboriginal communities and their culture and the Northern Health care providers at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia with the intent to improve access to service and quality of health care provided to Aboriginal patients and their families. The APLW is responsible for facilitating the exchange of information and assisting in problem solving between the patient/family and the healthcare professionals during the patient's episode of care.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Graduation from a recognized post-secondary degree program in Social Science; if applicable eligibility for registration with a regulatory body, plus
- One (1) years recent related experience in a healthcare setting.

- Knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal history and culture including local (specifically Carrier and Sekani) and other Canadian First Nations and Metis
- Knowledge of Carrier Clans and Potlatch system
- Knowledge of Cree and Metis customs
- Demonstrated Cultural Competency
- Computer skills
- Ability to deliver and promote cultural competent care that is based on understanding how differences in heritage and cultural background can impact a patient's response to an illness experience and their contact with the health care system
- Preferred fluency in English and Carrier Dialects
- Ability to communicate both verbally and in writing
- Ability to deal with others effectively
- Ability to organize work
- Physical ability to carry out the duties of the position
- Ability to operate related equipment
- Ability to work with limited supervision

WORKING/SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- Initial and on-going employment is subject to submission of a clear Criminal Record check. Criminal Record Check must be conducted every three years.
- Must possess a valid driver's license
