Qualifications:

Doctoral degree preferred in Psychology. Masters level degrees with significant experience with First Nation communities may be considered.

Preference will be given to applicants with recent Supervisory experience,

Excellent oral, written and interpersonal skills required,

Experience in, and / or openness to developing and delivering mental health programs within an indigenous framework. Completion of AFOT (*Aboriginal Focusing Oriented Therapy*) a definite asset.

Must be willing to work evenings and weekends as required.

Responsibilities:

Direct supervision of 2-3 masters-level Child & Youth Clinical Counsellors;

Possibly carry a small caseload of child & youth files, and/or parent & family files.
