The ECE educator is responsible for the following Key Result Areas (KRAs): a) planning and implementing developmentally and culturally appropriate activities and experiences for children; b) assisting in developing Mission Aboriginal Family Place ECE curriculum; c) developmental assessments and child records; d) conducting Community Sessions, home visits and family nights; e) ensuring positive communication with children, parents and other family members; f) Contributing to the on-going operation of the HS program; g) leading large and small groups and one-to-ones; h) assisting HS staff in providing experiences for the children and their families relating to the 7 HS components; and; i) performs other tasks as assigned and as so directed by the immediate Supervisor.
