Lu'ma Medical Centre is a brand new facility located at the corner of Nanaimo and Grandview, sitting adjacent to Lu'ma Native Housing Society.

Lu'ma Medical Centre provides a culturally safe and supportive space for Indigenous com munity members to access full-service family medicine as well as internal medicine services. Our long-term vision is to build this clinic into a model centre for Indigenous health and wellness, bringing together Indigenous ways of healing with Western medicine in a holistic way. We believe in improving health outcomes and patient experience for those for whom we have the pleasure to care.

Lu'ma is currently looking for a permanent family physician who would like to build up a practice and join in supporting the clinic's vision.

The team at Lu'ma believes this site will serve as a flagship for providing culturally safe care to the Indigenous community living in the Greater Vancouver Area. Potential physicians would have the freedom to build their own patient panels as well as subsidize their income and support the community by seeing walk-in traffic – at least in the early stages of the clinic.

Lu'ma is looking for physicians of all cultural backgrounds but will give preference to physicians identifying as First Nation, Inuit or Métis.

Currently, Lu'ma is a fee-for-service clinic. The facility is exploring opportunities to obtain additional funding supports to transition to an APP model and find partnering providers including traditional Healers, Elders, nurse practitioners and counseling professionals. In the meantime, Lu'ma will offer competitive revenue splits, a state of the art new facility and the opportunity to be part of an exciting new model for urban Indigenous health care.
