Consider the permanent, part time Nurse Practitioner opportunity based in Alexis Creek, BC, whose priority is supporting the First Nations' communities encompassing the Tsilhqot'in Nation. The Tsilhqot'in (pronounced Tsill-COAT-ten or Chilcotin) are an Aboriginal people with a population of over 3,200 who live between the Fraser River and the Coast Mountains in west-central British Columbia. Working collaboratively with other health professionals across the six First Nation's communities, the NP will provide full scope primary care including mental health and substance use and family services to women, men, infant and children's health.

Primarily a chronic disease management role, the NP may be required to do some health fairs, education and teaching. An existing NP is based in the Alexis Creek Outpost Hospital and a priority for this role will be to work collaboratively with the NP and health care team to determine health needs relevant to specific communities.

Providing NP clinics in the communities requires travel from community to community. The majority of the First Nations communities are geographically located within 200 km West of Williams Lake with one 70 km to the North. A valid BC Driver's License is necessary. Access to a personal vehicle will be required.
