## Call for Community Wellness Worker

**JOB TITLE: Community Wellness Worker (CWW)**

**Reports to: Health Director**

Kwakiutl Band Council (KBC) is seeking a dynamic / motivated / experienced part-time (28 hr./wk .8 FTE) Community Wellness Worker to work at the Health Centre in Fort Rupert—just outside of Port Hardy, BC. Dependent on funding, this could turn into a full-time position. Within scope of practice and credentials, you will provide assessment services and/or counselling for mental disorders, individual and family dysfunction and addiction; and within scope of practice provide counseling and Kwakiutl culturally appropriate programs / service. You will develop and deliver mental health and addiction programs and activities in consultation with health staff to support implementation of the health work plan in a culturally safe, healthy and supportive environment.

You must have a Bachelor of Social Work, or a recognized Human Service Bachelor of Art in Substance Abuse and/or Mental Health Counseling. You must be a role model with a minimum 2 years of continuous sobriety and a drug-free lifestyle. You must also be familiar with residential schools issues and the effect of residential schools upon First Nations' People. The CWW must demonstrate clear professional boundaries and appropriate accountability measures, file-management, eMR charts/records, and time management.

The successful candidate must also successfully undergo a Vulnerable Criminal Record Check. Preference may be given to qualified applicants who are of Aboriginal ancestry and applicants with direct experience in a recognized Human Service field.
