JOB TITLE: Mental Health and Substance Use Counsellor Reports to: Health Director

Kwakiutl Band Council (KBC) is seeking a dynamic individual to engage our community in positive health and wellness activities through best practices and clinical health indicators as a part-time (24.5 hours per week .7 FTE) Mental Health and Addictions Services Counsellor at the Kwakiutl Health Centre in Fort Rupert—just outside of Port Hardy, BC. This is a term position. Dependent on funding, this could turn into a full-time position.

You will provide trauma-informed treatment and rehabilitation services for individuals and families experiencing mental health and addictions issues, and will report to the Health Director. The ideal candidate will possess a Master's Degree and must be a registered professional clinical member of a regulatory body. You will have advanced clinical skill and professional maturity to maintain the highest level of client-centered, ethical psycho-social mental health care for our community members. Must be a self-starter and team oriented. You will also be a role model with a minimum 2 years of continuous sobriety and a drug-free lifestyle with familiarity of residential schools issues and the effect of residential schools upon First Nations' People. The MHASC must demonstrate clear professional boundaries and appropriate accountability measures, file-management, eMR charts/records of interventions, and time management.

Preference may be given to qualified applicants who are of Aboriginal ancestry and applicants with direct experience. The successful candidate must also successfully undergo a Vulnerable Criminal Record Check.
