LMC provides culturally integrated wellness education and disease prevention through: attachment to a primary care provider; access to traditional healers and Elders; and connection with mental health counsellors and social workers.

JOB SUMMARY

The Registered Nurse (RN) works to address client and family centred care supported by an integrated health team and service delivery model. You will practice within the Scope of Practice and Professional/Practice Standards of the British Columbia College of Nursing Professionals (BCCNP) standards of practice for registered nurses and within Lu'ma Medical Centre (LMC) policies, guidelines, and clinical practice documents. The RN cares for clients and families who are experiencing health challenges and are adversely affected by the social determinants of health. The RN's role will include: conducting physical and mental health assessments, identify problems, address issues or variances from the plan of care in collaboration with the LMC integrated health team. You will act as a resource for the health team by providing information and nursing support based on nursing theory and practice related to clients with complex health care needs, both in clinic and in an outreach capacity. The RN provides direct care activities such as assessing, planning, implementing, evaluating and documenting client care as part of the integrated health team and collaboratively with other services and resources within the broader health and wellness community.

- Graduation with a degree in nursing from a recognized post-secondary institution and current registration with the British Columbia College of Nursing Professionals (BCCNP)
- Experience delivering community and primary health care to Indigenous clients

- Experience providing leadership, coaching and training to members of an integrated health team
- Experience operating across multiple levels of care and within an interdisciplinary environment

- Indigenous cultural safety training is required or must be completed within the first 6 months of employment
