Working independently from a clinic situated within the community of Port Hardy, you will provide primary care services and support the delivery of culturally safe holistic health services for the Aboriginal Community members by working with the Gwa'sala-'Nakwaxda'xw (GNN), Kwakiutl First Nation (Fort Rupert), Sacred Wolf Friendship Centre and Quatsino First Nation and other key stakeholders.

With up to six other nurse practitioners in the region, new employees have the opportunity to mentor and be supported through the Mount Waddington Nurse Practitioner Community of Practice Group. This makes the position suitable to a new graduate or an experienced nurse practitioner.
