This position requires travel from Lytton to Chilliwack to provide Seabird Island health services including home care, community care and public health.

- Degree in Nursing, along with registration and licensing with CRNBC
- Post Basic education and experience in Maternal child health, pediatric Nursing, Maternity nursing or related field
- Home care, community care and public health experience is a benefit
- Direct related experience in a First Nations health services position or community public health environment an asset
- Computer literacy on database, windows, Microsoft Word and other computer programs
- Ability to work with community members, health professionals, and co-workers as a member of a multi-disciplinary team
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License
- High professional and ethical standards holding up the CRNBC Professional and Practice Standards including maintaining client confidentiality

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for providing home care, community care and public health services to Seabird Island and surrounding First Nation's communities
- Responsible for travelling from Lytton to Chilliwack in own vehicle
- Responsible for check-up and assessments on clients
- Develops a care plan for clients, following up and modifying as needed
- Offers advice on bathing, dressing, illnesses and other related topics of health care
- Assesses and refers clients to other programs and health specialists as needed
- Completes dressing changes and wound assessment
- Monitors patients for infections, illnesses etc.,
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date client records
- Responsible for collection of statistical data in relation to program and services
- Transports clients as required
- Other duties or responsibilities as assigned by your supervisor, Director, or the CEO
