Position Summary

Snuneymuxw Health Centre is a department of Snuneymuxw First Nation which is located adjacent to Nanaimo, B.C.

Reporting to the Home Care and Community Nursing Coordinator, the Home Care Worker (HCW) provides quality personal care and home support services specifically for elders, adults with disabilities, and individuals who are recuperating from an illness/injury, or who are incapacitated within the Snuneymuxw First Nation community. The HCW provides personal care duties in Snuneymuxw homes as well as provides supplementary care services for clients in an institutional setting (i.e. hospital, care facility). These services can include bathing, cleaning, transportation, meal preparation/cooking, shopping, laundry and other light duties associated with the well-being of clients. Overall, the HCW works towards promoting and maintaining the physical, psychological and social well-being of their adult care/elder care clientele.

Qualifications

1. Completion of Grade 12 and possesses a Home Care/Resident Care Attendant Certificate.
2. Registered with the British Columbia Care Aide and Community Health Care Registry and demonstrate good standing.
3. Successful completion of training in: First Aid AND CPR certification, WHMIS, ASSIST and dealing with emotional and troubled clients.
4. A tuberculosis (TB) test and proof of immunizations is required.
5. Possesses a Transfer/Medical Lift certificate.
6. Possesses a Food Safe Certificate.
7. Possesses a valid Driver's License.
8. A Palliative Care Certificate is desirable.
9. Excellent ability to work with elders and their families.
10. Ability to work as a team member as well as be self-directed; meet deadlines and prioritize workloads and manage several tasks at once.
11. Strong interpersonal skills; ability to establish and maintain effective and efficient working relationships with clients and their families, staff and community agencies/representatives.
12. Knowledge of Snuneymuxw First Nation cultural protocols/ traditional practices is desirable.
13. Proficient with transfers (i.e., beds, wheelchairs), bathing, feeding and other personal care duties.
14. Clearance of a criminal record check with vulnerable sector search.
