

Have Your Voice Heard: **First Nations Transportation Survey Highway 16 West**

The First Nations Health Authority and BC Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure are partnering on a transportation initiative and would like to hear from First Nations communities within the Prince Rupert to Prince George Highway 16 corridor.

The project is focused on developing practical transportation solutions to address both medical and non-medical travel. Hearing from First Nations along the Highway 16 corridor is the first step to implementing solutions.

An online survey is available with 14 questions and room for comment from members of the 23 First Nations communities within 75 km of Highway 16. The survey results and themes will provide a foundation for dialogue at a 2015 Transportation Symposium, which will be held this fall.
