Check Your Immunizations

- Review your records on Health Gateway.
- Missing records? Check with the provider where you received immunizations.





Know the Public Health Situation

 Before you travel, check for any disease outbreaks or health risks at your destination.

Within Canada

- BC Measles Exposures
- Alberta Measles Exposures





Catch-up on **Immunizations**

Visit your CHN, Public Health Unit or pharmacist.

If you are travelling outside of Canada, you should visit a travel clinic.



Take Precautions

- Wash your hands often.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- If you are immunocompromised, follow advice from your health care provider

The journey may be behind you, but prevention is ongoing.



When you Return Home

Protect the health of your family and friends by ensuring you are well when you visit those who are not able to be vaccinated, or who may be immunocompromised.
