
- First Nations in BC have been clear in their calls for:
 - Nations want a Nation-to-Nation relationship with Canada
 - Desire for flexible funding envelopes
 - Desire to integrate health and social services by reducing silos, removing rules and significantly simplifying the process for accessing federal funding
 - Desire for reduced reporting burden with a focus on outcomes
 - Evolve government role from a service provider to a partner in supporting community-led change
 - Build relationships based on recognition, respect and reciprocal accountability


