Healing Begins

- Intake selection
- Pre and Post Evaluation for clients
- Oral evaluation of program upon completion
- Written evaluation upon completion
- Facilitators evaluation
- Elders supporting program Evaluation
- Follow up at 1 week
- Follow up at 3 weeks
